CORPORATE AND ECONOMY NEWS

- Mahindra & Mahindra: The auto major has launched Mahindra XUV 400, India's first fully electric SUV. The company said it would take customer feedback over the next three months before deciding on pricing. Prices will be announced early-January 2023 and deliveries will start by January-end.
- Titagarh Wagons: The agency of the Government of Italy has made an equity infusion of 10 million euros into the company's subsidiary - Titagarh Firema. Thirdparty private equity investors from the UAE have also infused equity worth 4.5 million euros in the subsidiary company. The investment has been made after signing an agreement earlier in July and after securing all necessary approvals.
- HDFC Bank: Private sector lender HDFC Bank on Thursday said it has mobilised Rs.3,000 crore from bonds to fund business growth. The bank issued and allotted bonds to investors on a private placement basis on Thursday, HDFC Bank said in a regulatory filing. These unsecured, subordinated, fully paid-up, non-convertible, Basel III compliant perpetual debt would carry a coupon rate of 7.84%, it added.
- Vodafone Idea: The government will acquire a stake in Vodafone Idea after the stock price of the company stabilises at Rs 10 or above, PTI reported. The company's board has offered a stake to the government at a par value of Rs 10 per share.
- NTPC: NTPC has reached an agreement with the armed forces to supply renewable energy power, according to reports. This is the first agreement by Indian armed forces to procure power from renewable energy sources, the report added.
- Tata Power: Tata Power Renewable Energy Limited, an arm of Tata Power, on Thursday said it will set up a 100 MW solar power plant for Viraj Profile in Maharashtra. Viraj Profile Private Limited (VPPL) is a stainless steel manufacturer, which owns and operates a plant located at Tarapur at Nandgaon. In a statement, Tata Power Renewable Energy Limited (TPREL) said, "It has collaborated with VPL to set up a 100 MW captive solar plant. The plant is expected to generate about 200 MUs of energy and offset approximately 170.43 million Kg of CO2 annually.
- Titagarh Wagons: The agency of the Government of Italy has made an equity infusion of 10 million euros into the company's subsidiary - Titagarh Firema. Thirdparty private equity investors from the UAE have also infused equity worth 4.5 million euros in the subsidiary company. The investment has been made after signing an agreement earlier in July and after securing all necessary approvals.
- GMR Power and Urban Infra: Stepdown subsidiary GMR Warora Energy has entered into a definitive agreements with its lenders to restructure debt through a Resolution plan. Interest rate on sustainable debt worth Rs 2,350 crore will be revised to 8.50 percent per annum while unsustainable debt of Rs 788 crore will carry an interest rate of 0.01 percent per annum.
- Reliance Power: The company has issued to VFSI Holdings Pte up to 60 crore equity shares and/or warrants convertible into equity shares at Rs 15.55 apiece. The deal aggregates to Rs 933 crore.
- Samvardhana Motherson: Auto components maker Samvardhana Motherson International Ltd on Thursday said it will acquire Daimler India Commercial Vehicles' (DICV) frame manufacturing and assembly operations facilities in Chennai. The company has signed a strategic agreement including a long-term deal with DICV for the supply of the complete frame assembly as a part of the transaction, Samvardhana Motherson International Ltd (SAMIL) said in a regulatory filing.
- PNC Infratech: PNC Infratech signs an agreement for a Hybrid Annuity Model (HAM) project worth Rs.1,458 cr with the National Highways Authority of India (#NHAI), according to reports. Upon declaration of the appointed date, The project is to be constructed within 24 months and operated for 15 years post-construction.
- KRBL/LT Foods/GRM Overseas: The Indian government has imposed a 20% duty on exports of unmilled rice.

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GLOBAL MARKETS

Global Market Update

Wall Street's main indices posted gains on Thursday mainly lifted by financial institutions and healthcare companies, as investors digested hawkish remarks from policymakers that cemented bets of a large interest rate hike later this month. Indices bounced back and forth in choppy trading as concerns over the Federal Reserve's next steps to tame a surging inflation remain. The Dow Jones Industrial Average rose 193.24 points, or 0.61 percent, to 31,774.52, the S&P 500 gained 26.31 points, or 0.66 percent, to 4,006.18 and the Nasdaq Composite added 70.23 points, or 0.6 percent, to 11,862.13.

Crude Oil

Oil prices turned down in early trade on Friday after a slight rebound in the previous session, leaving them set to fall for a second straight week on worries that central banks' aggressive rate hikes and China's COVID-19 curbs will hurt demand. Brent crude futures slipped 12 cents, or 0.1%, to \$89.03 a barrel at 0051 GMT, after rising 1.3% on Thursday. U.S. West Texas Intermediate (WTI) crude futures fell 19 cents, or 0.2%, to \$83.35 a barrel, after climbing 2% in the previous session.

SGX Nifty: Trends in SGX Nifty indicate a positive opening for the broader index in India with a gain of 46 points. The Nifty futures were trading around 17,865 levels on the Singaporean exchange.

Nifty Outlook:

Nifty opened gap up on Thursday at 17748, made a high of 17808, made a low of 17692, and closed on a positive note at 17799 levels. For the day, support for the Nifty exists at 17690 and 17500 levels, whereas resistance for the Nifty stands at 17900 and 18000 levels.

Bank Nifty Outlook:

Bank Nifty opened gap down on Wednesday at 39338 made a high of 39572 made a low of 39258, and closed on a negative note at 39456 levels. For the day, support for Bank Nifty exists at 39200 and 39000 levels, whereas resistance for Bank Nifty stands at 39800 and 40100 levels.
